1. Charades

2. Pictionary

6. Freeze Dance



Similar to Red Light, Green Light, Freeze Dance involves playing music and dancing. When the music stops, the players must freeze in place.

7. Musical Chairs



This is a classic party game that is always a lot of fun. Place one less chair than the number of players in a circle. Play music and have the players walk around the chairs. When the music stops, the players must quickly sit down in a chair. The player who is left without a chair is out.

8. Truth or Dare



Truth or Dare is a classic game that can be a lot of fun for older children and adults. One person asks another person "Truth or Dare?" If they choose "Truth," they must answer a question honestly. If they choose "Dare," they must do whatever the other person dares them to do.

9. Would You Rather?



This is a fun game that can spark some interesting conversations. One person asks another person "Would you rather..." followed by two different choices. The other person must choose which choice they would rather have.

10. Never Have I Ever



This is a fun game that can be a bit revealing. One person starts by saying "Never have I ever..." followed by something they have never done. If any of the other players have done that thing, they must take a drink.

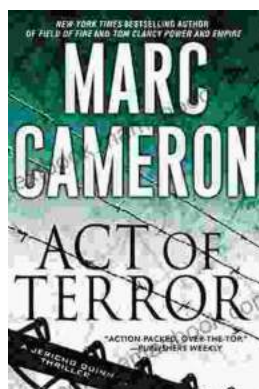
