hdc	Half double crochet

inc	Increase (2 sc in one stitch)

Pattern Instructions:

Body:

1. With brown yarn, ch 2.
2. Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sts)
3. Round 2: (inc) 6 times. (12 sts)
4. Round 3: (sc, inc) 6 times. (18 sts)
5. Round 4: (sc, inc) 6 times. (24 sts)

6. Round 5-10: 24 sc. (24 sts)
7. Round 11: (sc, dec) 6 times. (18 sts)
8. Round 12: (sc, dec) 6 times. (12 sts)
9. Round 13: (sc, dec) 6 times. (6 sts)
10. Close the opening and leave a long tail for sewing.

Shell:

1. With beige yarn, ch 6.
2. Round 1: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc in each ch across. (6 sts)
3. Round 2: (hdc, inc) 6 times. (12 sts)
4. Round 3: (hdc, inc) 6 times. (18 sts)
5. Round 4: (hdc, inc) 6 times. (24 sts)
6. Round 5-7: 24 hdc. (24 sts)
7. Change to white yarn.
8. Round 8: (hdc, dec) 6 times. (18 sts)
9. Round 9: (hdc, dec) 6 times. (12 sts)
10. Change to beige yarn.
11. Round 10: (hdc, dec) 6 times. (6 sts)
12. Close the opening and leave a long tail for sewing.

Head:

1. With brown yarn, ch 2.

2. Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sts)
3. Round 2: (inc) 6 times. (12 sts)
4. Round 3: 12 sc. (12 sts)
5. Round 4: (sc, dec) 6 times. (6 sts)
6. Close the opening and leave a long tail for sewing.

Eyes:

1. With black yarn, ch 2.
2. Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sts)
3. Close the opening and leave a long tail for sewing.
4. Repeat for the second eye.

Assembly:

1. Sew the body and shell together, aligning the opening of the shell with the top of the body.
2. Sew the head to the body, just above the shell.
3. Sew the eyes to the head.
4. Stuff the snail with polyfil stuffing until it is firm but not too hard.
5. Enjoy your adorable Elias Aldada snail amigurumi!

Tips:

- Use a stitch marker to keep track of the beginning of each round.

- Count your stitches carefully to ensure that you have the correct number in each round.
- Stuff the snail evenly to give it a nice shape.
- If you want to add a smile to your snail, embroider a small curved line on the head.

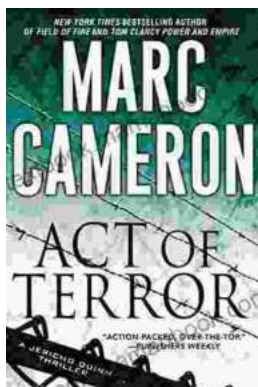
