- 1. Round 1: Ch 1, sc across the front of the vest, joining to the first stitch of the back.
- 2. Round 2: Ch 1, sc across the back of the vest, joining to the last stitch of the front.
- 3. Repeat Round 2 until the shoulders reach the desired width.

Finishing

1. Fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.

2. Block the vest by gently stretching it and pinning it to shape. Allow to dry completely.





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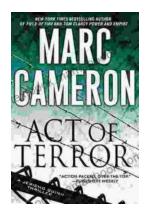






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
