
Letter to Thomas Bayard: A Plea for Human Rights and International Cooperation in the Aftermath of the Venezuelan Crisis



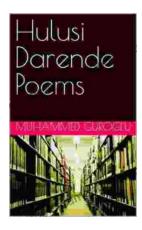

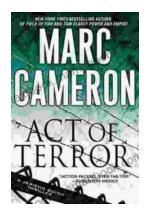
