
Phoenix Christmas: An Out for Justice Holiday Short Story

"Merry Christmas, Miles," Phoenix said.



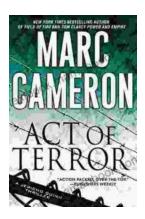
